



# CHAUDHARY CHARAN SINGH UNIVERSITY, MEERUT


## General Rules regarding semester system for all courses

(Applicable w.e.f. 2017-18 session)

1. A Course / Degree will be of 1/2/3/4/5 years duration consisting of 2/4/6/8/10 semesters, respectively.
2. Maximum number of years to complete the Degree for 1/2/3/4/5 year course will be 2/4/6/8/8 years, respectively. The duration will be counted from the date of admission to first semester for the first time.
3. Each semester will have a number of theory papers and zero, one or more non theory papers such as practical, project, viva, seminar, dissertation, group discussion etc. Suppose N is the number of papers in a semester.  
Recommendation: Each semester may have at most one such non theory paper except for the last semester of the course where there can be at most two non theory papers, except otherwise recommended by respective regulatory bodies like BCI, NCTE etc.
4. Each paper will have a minimum passing marks of x %. Each semester will have an aggregate of y% minimum passing marks. The whole course/degree will have a minimum of y% Grand total, same as semester passing marks. A student shall be eligible for the pass degree of the course only after having cleared all the semester examinations separately.
5. A student will be declared as having failed in a semester if he / she fails in more than  $[N/2]$  (i.e. more than half the number) of all the papers (theory and non theory papers put together) of that semester.  $[N/2] = 0, 1, 1, 2, 2, 3, 3, 4, 4, 5$ , for  $N=1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10$ , respectively. Such students failing in more than  $[N/2]$  papers will be eligible for semester back where he/she will have to repeat all the papers of that semester again as ex-student.
6. A student who fulfills the minimum required percentage of attendance criteria in a semester and duly filled up and submitted the examination form with required fees for appearing in the examination of concerned semester shall be entitled to be promoted to the next semester irrespective of the result of previous semester(s).
7. A student shall be allowed to appear in back papers of at most  $[N/2]$  papers only in each semester however he / she shall have to opt the same subjects as opted initially in regular exam papers.
8. Odd semester back shall be allowed with odd semester examination and even semester back with even semester examination.
9. In no case, a student is allowed to appear in examinations of two semesters simultaneously, for example, a student carrying a semester back of 1st semester shall not be allowed in any paper of 1st semester along with 3rd semester examination. A student is allowed to appear in only one semester (odd/even as the case may be) exam. To clear the semester back a student shall have to appear separately.


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10. If a candidate is absent in a paper in regular semester examination or back paper examination, he will be treated as failed in that paper and he/she may take back paper examination in the next corresponding semester provided the limit of [N/2] above. A student may be allowed to appear in the back paper examination more than once but within the duration of the maximum period of completion of the course in point number 2 above.
11. Appearance in a back paper examination of a paper already passed, for improvement is allowed subject to the conditions laid down in points no. 2,7,8,9 & 10 above.
12. In PG courses a student has to secure x% (minimum percentage of) marks to pass the internal and external examinations in each paper separately. If a candidate fails to pass in the internal assessment of a paper, he/she will not be eligible to appear in the external exam of that paper. If a candidate passes the internal assessment of a paper and fails in the external exam of that paper, he/she will have to pass that paper only in external examination as back paper/ Ex student. The marks secured by him/her previously in internal assessment will be considered as such.
13. In UG courses a student has to pass a paper by securing x% (minimum percentage of) marks the internal and external examinations put together (unless otherwise specified in the syllabus of that course). If a candidate passes the internal assessment of a paper and fails in the external exam of that paper, he/she will have to pass that paper only in external examination as back paper/ Ex student. The marks secured by him/her previously in internal assessment will be considered as such.
14. Grace: (a) Upto 05 marks in one paper / two papers taken together to attain minimum passing marks in each paper. (b) Upto 03 marks for meeting aggregate of minimum passing marks. (c) No grace marks for Practical / project work / Viva-Voce / Seminar / Dissertation or any other such non-theory paper. (d) a grace of 03 marks for division improvement. (e) Grace marks will not be added to total marks obtained. (f) These grace marks are given only in UG courses and there is no provision of grace marks in PG.
15. If there is any contradiction in these rules and the rules laid down by respective regularity body such as BCI, NCTE etc., rules laid down by respective regularity body shall have an over riding effect.
16. These rules shall be applicable to the students admitted in First semester of session 2017-18.
