

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

On this day 1st April 2022, at Ghaziabad.

This MOU is made between INDERPRASTHA DENTAL COLLEGE & HOSPITAL, 46/1, SITE IV, Industrial area, Sahibabad, Ghaziabad, U.P – 201010, represented through its Secretary Mr. Nimish Agarwal, hereinafter referred to as the "COLLEGE"

AND

between Mr. Manoj Chaudhary, Councilor of RaispurVillage, District Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh, hereinafter referred to as the COUNCILOR.

The COLLEGE will adopt the village for dental healthcare and establish a Charitable Dental Clinic in the premises of Samudaik Kendra, RaispurVillage, Shaheed Bhagat Singh Chowk, Ghaziabad, Uttar Pradesh for the charitable dental treatment of the residents of village.

The COUNCILOR shall provide free of charge the following infrastructure for setting up of the Dental Clinic.

The COUNCILOR shall provide free of charge water and drainage services.

The COLLEGE shall install an electric connection at its own costs, and shall provide all equipment for setting up of dental clinic including Dental Chair, Air Compressor, Autoclave, Scaler, X-Ray etc.

The COLLEGE shall also provide manpower for running of the clinic.

The COLLEGE shall also provide consumables for the dental clinic such as tooth filling, X-Ray film etc.

The COLLEGE shall run charitable Dental Clinic within the premises of the Samudaik Kendra, once a week i.e, Tuesday from 9:00 a.m to 2:00 p.m during which the COLLEGE shall provide the required manpower to treat the patients of the village.



Also, it is to be noted that not all the dental treatments can be done with the limited manpower and equipment available at the village premises. Hence the COLLEGE may advise the patient to visit the COLLEGE for full dental treatment and it is optional for the patient to seek dental treatment at the premises of the COLLEGE or elsewhere. If however the patient chooses to get the dental treatment at the premises of the COLLEGE then such treatment shall be on chargeable basis at the prevailing rates of the COLLEGE at that time.


The COUNCILOR shall provide adequate security to ensure no incident of theft/robbery take place.

The COUNCILOR shall provide complete cooperation to the manpower of the COLLEGE working in their premises.

This MOU is valid for a period of 2 years from the date of signing, and can be renewed further subject to consent of both of COLLEGE and the COUNCILOR, in writing only. If due to any reasons/dispute this MOU is discontinued, then:-

- The COUNCILOR shall be liable to Return all equipment of the COLLEGE.
- Neither the COUNCILOR nor the COLLEGE shall be liable for reimbursement of any expenditure or investment made towards this MOU.
- All disputes shall be subject to jurisdiction of Ghaziabad.

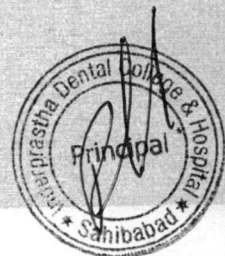

The COLLEGE will establish a Charitable Dental Clinic in the premises Makan No. 470, Parshad Himanshu Chaudhary wali gall, Gram Sahibabad, Thana Link Road, District Ghaziabad for the dental treatment of the residents of village.

The NIGAM PARSHAD shall provide free of charge the following infrastructure for setting up of the Dental Clinic.

The COLLEGE shall provide electricity bill according to the sub meter reading.

The COLLEGE shall provide one clinical assistant as manpower for the clinic.

The COLLEGE shall provide free of charge all equipment for setting up of a dental clinic including Dental Chair, Air Compressor, Autoclave, Scaler, X-Ray etc. and equipment will be fully insured by COLLEGE.

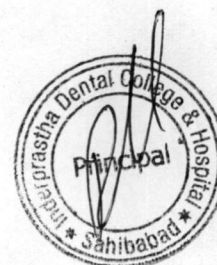
The COLLEGE shall also provide free of charge manpower including one Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS) doctor.

The COLLEGE shall also provide free of charge consumables such as tooth filling, X-Ray film etc.

The COLLEGE shall run free of charge Dental Clinic within the premises of the NIGAM PARSHAD on a regular basis, indicative frequency of the same be 6 days a week (Sunday off) from 9:00 a.m to 2:00 p.m during which the COLLEGE shall provide the required manpower to treat the patients of the NIGAM PARSHAD free of charge.

COLLEGE will stick to the schedule throughout the 2 years.

Also, it is to be noted that not all the dental treatments can be done with the limited manpower and equipment available at the NIGAM PARSHAD premises. Hence the COLLEGE may advice the patient to visit the COLLEGE for full dental treatment and it is optional for



the patient to seek dental treatment provided within the NIGAM PARSHAD premises shall be free of charge, but any treatment done in the premises of the college shall be payable at prevailing rates of college.

The NIGAM PARSHAD shall provide adequate security to ensure no incident to theft/robbery take place.

The NIGAM PARSHAD shall provide complete cooperation to the manpower of the COLLEGE working in their premises.





The COLLEGE will establish a Charitable Dental Clinic in the premises Silai Center, Near Madir Chowk, Gharoli Village (Near Mayur Vihar Phase-3), Delhi-92 for the dental treatment of the residents of the Village.

The SANGH shall also try to provide one English speaking Assistant as manpower for the Clinic.

The COLLEGE shall provide free of charge all equipment for setting up of a Dental Clinic including Dental Chair, Air Compressor, Autoclave, Scalar, X-ray etc. and equipment will be fully Insured by the COLLEGE.

The COLLEGE shall also provide free of charge manpower including one Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS) doctor.

The COLLEGE shall also provide free of charge consumable such as tooth filling, x-ray film etc.

The COLLEGE shall run free of charge Dental Clinic within the premises of the SANGH on a regular basis. Indicative frequency of the same shall be 6 days a week (Sunday Off) from 9.00 a.m. to 2.00 p.m. during which the COLLEGE shall provide the required manpower to treat the patients of the SANGH free of charge. COLLEGE will stick to the schedule throughout the 2 years.

Hence the COLLEGE may advise the patient to visit the COLLEGE for full dental treatment, and it is optional for the patient to seek dental treatment provided within the SANGH premises shall be free of charge, but any treatment done in the premises of the college shall be payable at prevailing rates of the College.

The SANGH shall provide adequate security to ensure no incident to theft / robbery take place.

The SANGH shall provide complete cooperation to the manpower of the COLLEGE working in their premises.



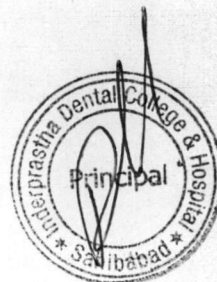

The COLLEGE will establish a Charitable Dental Clinic in the premises of the Temple Complex of Village Nischoli for the dental treatment of the residents of the Village.

The COLLEGE shall also provide free of charge manpower including one Bachelor of Dental Surgery (BDS) doctor and one Attendant.

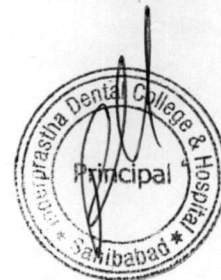
The COLLEGE shall also provide free of charge consumables such as tooth filling, x-ray film etc.

The COLLEGE shall conduct free of charge Dental Camps within the premises of the PANCHAYAT on a regular basis. Indicative frequency of the same shall be 6 days a week (Sunday off) from 9:30 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. during which the COLLEGE shall provide the required manpower to treat the patients of the PANCHAYAT free of charge. The above schedule is indicative only, and the COLLEGE reserves the right to vary the schedule as per availability of manpower, without any prior notice. The COLLEGE reserves the right to change the designated manpower without any prior notice.

Also it is to be noted that not all dental treatments can be done with the limited manpower and equipment available at the PANCHAYAT premises. Hence the COLLEGE may advise the

patient to visit the COLLEGE for full dental treatment, and it is optional for the patient to seek dental treatment from the COLLEGE or from some other Dental Clinic thereafter.

The PANCHAYAT shall be fully responsible for security of the equipment of the COLLEGE in their premises, and shall provide round the clock security to ensure no incident of theft / robbery takes place. Any loss due to theft / damage caused by lack of security shall be compensated in full to the COLLEGE by the PANCHAYAT.

The PANCHAYAT shall provide complete cooperation to the manpower of the COLLEGE working in their premises.

This MOU is valid for a period of 5 years from the date of implementation, and can be renewed further subject to consent of both the COLLEGE and the PANCHAYAT. If due to any reason / dispute this MOU is discontinued:-

1. The PANCHAYAT shall be liable to return all equipment of the COLLEGE.
2. Neither the PANCHAYAT nor the COLLEGE shall be liable for reimbursement of expenditure or investment made towards this MOU.
3. All disputes shall be subject to jurisdiction of Ghaziabad.

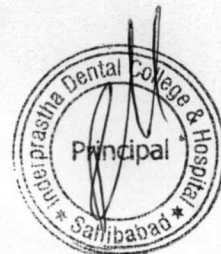
